City Rail Link is New Zealand's largest ever transport infrastructure project, aiming to greatly improve connectivity of the Auckland rail network and allowing it to almost quadruple its capacity.

It includes twin 3.5km rail tunnels underneath Auckland's CBD, with two new underground stations and the redevelopment of two existing stations. A combination of cut-and-cover, TBM, and mined tunnelling techniques were used.
