Project Description

The Great Northern Highway Realignment Project involved realigning an 8km section of a major road around the Wedgefield industrial area in Port Hedland in Western Australia's remote Pilbara region. The project scope also included a major road interchange, a new road bridge over BHP's iron ore rail line, a level bridge at South Creek, and new intersections.
