### Project Description

The Tarraleah Redevelopment Project is part of Hydro Tasmania's Battery of the Nation initiative, aimed at upgrading the existing hydropower system to increase capacity and flexibility.

The project will enhance the Tarraleah scheme, one of Tasmania's most important power stations, with a new 190 MW power station located adjacent to the existing one in the Nive Valley.
