The Tunnel & Station Excavation (TSE) project is the second stage of the Sydney Metro network that connects stage 1 at Chatswood to the existing heavy rail at Sydenham. The connection consists of twin 15.5km TBM tunnels that cross beneath Sydney Harbour and includes the complex excavation of underground caverns to facilitate new stations at Chatswood, Crows Nest, Victoria Cross, Barangaroo, Martin Place and Pitt Street (Gadigal) with an open cut station box excavation at Waterloo.
