


Dubbo/Mudgee/Dunedoo Region, NSW



Project Description

As the first NSW renewable energy zone developed by EnergyCo, the project will build new high-capacity transmission lines, energy hubs and supporting infrastructure to transfer power generated by solar and wind farms to electricity consumers. The project consists of 90km of 500kV overhead transmission lines and 150km of 330kV transmission lines for generator connections, from Elong Elong to Barigan Creek via an energy hub at Merotherie. The infrastructure is expected to be operational by 2028 and will initially unlock up to 4.5GW of new network capacity.
